Pierre Lurton, the director of Chateau Cheval Blanc and president of Chateau D'Yquem heads the team behind this Argentinian gem. The chief winemaker is Nicolas Audebert. Previously Nicholas had been responsible for Krug Grand Cuvee Champagne. The wine is produced from ancient plots of Argentinian Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot. Cheval Des Andes is a superb, subtle blend of these varietals in keeping with the style of fine claret. A wine with deep colour, it has flavours of pink grapefruit, black cherries and vanilla. It is silky on the palate, with fine grain tannins, smoky tobacco notes and hints of rosemary and mint on the finish.
